To all bidders:

The LCDOT Insurance special provision 107.27, has been revised to match the insurance limits and requirements of Article 107.27 of the "Standard Specifications". Please replace page 10 of 216 and page 11 of 216 in the Contract Specifications with the attached pages 10 and 11 (revised 12/5/16).

Details for the proposed curb and gutter (abutting existing pavement) and the underlying proposed aggregate base have been revised to show a 9" flag thickness and a 9" depth for the aggregate base course. The detail for the aggregate base has also been revised to show the aggregate extending 6" behind the back of curb. These revisions resulted in changes to the following pay items:

- 20200100 Earth Excavation – Increased from 3419.0 cu yd to 3895.0 cu yd
- 35101400 Aggregate Base Course Type B – Increased from 4856.0 tons to 6202.0 tons
- 66900205 Special Waste Disposal – Increased from 982.0 cu yd to 1165.0 cu yd

The above changes required revisions to the following plan sheets:

- Sheet 4 Summary of Quantities – Earth Excavation; Aggregate Base Course Type B; and Special Waste Disposal quantities.
- Sheets 6 & 7 Typical Sections – Curb and Gutter flag thickness; Aggregate Base thickness and width behind the curb.
- Sheet 8 Quantity Schedules – Schedule 3 Earthwork – Increased quantities.
- Sheet 15 Quantity Schedules – Schedule 7 Aggregate Base Course – Increased quantities.
- Sheets 19-28 Quantity Schedules – Schedule 15 Concrete Curb & Combination Concrete Curb and Gutter – Revised Earth Excavation Cut and Special Waste Disposal.
- Sheets 102-134 – Cross Sections – Revised Cut end areas.

The traffic control equipment note, included on sheets 73 – 80, has been revised to clarify the equipment required for the specific type of installation (temporary or permanent signals). Additionally, the information in the Electrical Service Requirements table on sheet 82 has been completed.


Due to the sheer number of revised plan sheets they have not been attached to this Addendum. Instead, a complete revised plan set (Revision Date December 5, 2016) including all of the above listed revised plan sheets has been placed on the LCDOT Bids-Roadwork web page:

The revised plan set shall be used by Contractors to prepare their proposals.

The CBID has been revised to include the Earth Excavation; Aggregate Base Course Type B; and Special Waste Disposal quantity changes. **Bidders shall ensure they are using the CBID with version date 5-Dec-16** when preparing and submitting their bid proposal.

ARTICLE 107.27 INSURANCE (LCDOT)

Effective: January 1, 2007

Revised: November 28, 2016

The Contractor shall obtain and thereafter keep in force insurance according to Article 107.27 of the “Standard Specifications” and the following:

The contractual liability insurance coverage shall be broad enough to respond to the liability assumed by the Contractor in the following Hold Harmless Clause:

Hold Harmless Clause

The Provider agrees to indemnify, save harmless and defend the County of Lake, its agents, servants, and employees and each of them against and hold it and them harmless from any and all lawsuits, claims, demands, liabilities, losses and expenses, including court costs and attorney’s fees, for or on account of any injury to any person, or any death at any time resulting from such injury, or any damage to property, which may arise or which may be alleged to have arisen out of or in connection with the work covered by this contract. The foregoing indemnity shall apply except if such injury, death or damage is caused directly by the willful and wanton conduct of the County of Lake, its agents, servants, or employees or any other person indemnified hereunder.

In the event the Contractor fails to obtain or maintain any insurance coverage required under this agreement, Lake County may purchase such insurance coverage and charge the expense thereof to the Contractor.

ARTICLE 107.29 OPENING OF SECTION OF HIGHWAY TO TRAFFIC (LCDOT)

Effective: January 1, 2007

Revised: May 19, 2014

Work under construction shall be opened to traffic according to Article 107.29 of the “Standard Specifications” and the following:

The Contractor shall work expeditiously to open traffic lanes closed due to roadwork. The Engineer shall be the sole judge of when a lane is ready to be opened to traffic. The opening of a lane to traffic shall be in accordance to Section 107.29 of the “Standard Specifications”.

Roadwork requiring a closure of a lane, which has been opened previously to traffic, will be allowed at the discretion of the Engineer and under the following conditions:

- 1. The lane closure shall only be in effect while workers are present in or near the closed lane.*
- 2. The closed lane will be reopened to traffic at the end of the workday.*
- 3. All traffic control devices pertaining to the lane closure shall be removed from the roadway at the end of the workday.*
