Subcontractors and suppliers that would like to be placed on the Not For Bid plan pick up list must also submit a Request for Authorization to Bid, filling out Part B and Part C.

A 5% security deposit or bid bond must accompany the bid. The successful bidder must furnish a satisfactory performance bond and a payment bond each in the full amount of the bid.

The Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130), as amended, shall apply to all contracts entered into pursuant to this advertisement.
