Notice is hereby given that sealed bids will be received at the office of the County Engineer at the Lake County Division of Transportation office at 600 W. Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois until 10:00 a.m. on **September 27, 2016** for the following:

This work consists of supplying bituminous patching mixture (group II), hot-mix asphalt binder and surface materials, aggregate surface course material, limestone screenings, and trench backfill aggregate to be loaded into LCDOT trucks at the suppliers location. The work also includes supplying and delivering sign materials – posts, reflective sheeting, and sign bases; preformed plastic pavement markings and pavement marking tape; calcium chloride; plastic, reinforced concrete, and corrugated metal pipe; concrete structures; and cast iron frames, lids and grates, for the Lake County Division of Transportation, 2016 Patrol 1 Maintenance contract.

Proposals from bidders that have not received authorization to bid will not be opened and read. Subcontractors and suppliers that would like to be placed on the Not For Bid plan pick up list must also submit a Request for Authorization to Bid, filling out Part B and Part C.

A 5% security deposit or bid bond must accompany the bid. The successful bidder must furnish a satisfactory performance bond and a payment bond each in the full amount of the bid.

The Prevailing Wage Act (820 ILCS 130), as amended, shall apply to all contracts entered into pursuant to this advertisement.

Lake County, in accordance with laws of the State of Illinois, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that all contracts entered into pursuant to this advertisement will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder without discrimination on grounds of race, color or national origin.
