# RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Lindenhurst is commencing a yearlong anniversary celebration in honor of the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of its incorporation on October 1, 1956 and

**WHEREAS**, Lee R. Lewis served as the first Mayor of the Village of Lindenhurst, when the village's population was 916 residents; and

**WHEREAS**, Mayor Jim Betustak is the 8<sup>th</sup> Mayor to serve the Village, which now boasts a population of over 14,000 and is still growing; and

**WHEREAS**, LindenFrost will kick off the yearlong anniversary celebration with a free day of family fun on Saturday, January 21, 2006, and will take place in three venues: Millennium Park, the Lake County Forest Preserve District's Bonner Farm, and the First Midwest Bank; and

**WHEREAS**, 50,000 daffodil bulbs were planted in the fall of 2005, and Lindenhurst will bloom as "Daffodil City" in the spring of 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, an Old Fashion Picnic will be held in the Village in the summer of 2006, along with Lindenfest, an annual tradition since 1983 to be held in August 2006; and

**WHEREAS**, other events to be held in 2006 include an October Anniversary Celebration and a Veteran's Memorial Dedication to be held on November 11, 2006.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that we do hereby congratulate the Village of Lindenhurst as they celebrate their 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Chairman Suzi Schmidt and the Members of the County Board extend to the Lindenhurst village officials our best wishes on the occasion of their anniversary celebrations in the year 2006, as they recognize the people and events that have shaped and influenced the community over the past 50 years.
