RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the State's Attorney has received a notice of extension for the Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Prosecution Grant Agreement Number 404023, in the amount of \$341,344, awarded by the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority (ICJIA) for the time period April 1, 2005 through July 31, 2006; and

WHEREAS, pending the receipt of the program agreement from the ICJIA for the extension of the State's Attorneys Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Prosecution grant, the County Board approved \$341,344 for the 16 month period April 1, 2005 – July 31, 2006; and

WHEREAS, it should be noted that it will be necessary for the County to provide additional compensation and benefits valued at approximately \$413,076 above the required 25% match, without reimbursement from the ICJIA; and

WHEREAS, the \$868,201 program budget as submitted to ICJIA consists of federal funds in the amount of \$341,344, local matching funds in the amount of \$113,781 which shall be provided as follows; State's Attorneys Asset Forfeiture \$40,000 from account 760.3318010 and \$73,781 from the State's Attorneys Office from account 101.3300010, \$413,076 (see table below); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the extension as described herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, that the extension of the State's Attorneys Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Prosecution Grant, in the amount of \$341,344 for the period beginning April 1, 2005 through July 31, 2006, is hereby accepted; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairman of the Board, the Lake County State's Attorney, and the Lake County Treasurer are hereby authorized to execute the necessary documentation in order to accept the extension (grant program agreement to be attached hereto and hereby made a part of this Resolution); and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that offsetting revenue in the amount of \$341,344 from the ICJIA, \$40,000 from account 760.3318010 and \$73,781 from account 101.3300010, will be deposited in the proper revenue account; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the State's Attorney shall serve as project director for the program, and accurate records of all necessary grant compliance requirements shall be kept by the State's Attorneys Office.

Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Prosecution Program

This is an amendment to extend the Multi-Jurisdictional Drug Prosecution Program, a federal grant administered through the Illinois Criminal Justice Information Authority from April 1, 2005 through July 31, 2006. Funding for this grant began in 1988 and has been renewed each year.

- This program is funding for four Assistant State's Attorneys, two secretaries, one paralegal, and one investigator dedicated to the prosecution of drug-related offenses.

Program goals:

- To deter drug-related crime through criminal investigations and prosecution. From April 1, 2005, through January 31, 2006, the State's Attorneys Office initiated 522 felony drug prosecutions.
- To focus the prosecution of drug-related crimes consistent with recent legislative changes that have increased emphasis and penalties on various drug-related offenses.
- To increase the Lake County State's Attorneys Office cooperative effort with local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies in conducting pre-arrest investigations and subsequent prosecutions to identify, track, and prosecute drug-related trafficking, conspiracies, and other offenses.
- To further engage these appointed Assistant State's Attorneys and support staff to act as prosecutorial liaisons for police trainings, legal updates, and case-related issues involving community drug-related prosecutions.
