FOR PERIOD ENDING OCTOBER 31, 2006

The Commissioners, individually, and by and through the engineering firm of JAMES ANDERSON COMPANY, performed numerous inspections of the ditch during the period ending October 31, 2006.

The Commissioners reviewed and secured grants for additional streambank stabilization projects and participated in joint projects involving the Lake County Stormwater Management Commission and other governmental stakeholders.

The District continued to maintain and repair both open ditch and underground pipes within the District's drainage system. The Commissioners authorized further disbursements in furtherance of the completion of pipe repair projects and removal of obstructions from the ditch.
