Title

Joint Resolution authorizing the execution of the final IDOT Local Agency Agreement for jurisdictional transfer of the one remaining segment of Harris Road from IL Route 137 to Peterson Rd from the Village of Grayslake to Lake County to become part of the Midlothian Rd Extension (County Highway 48).

Staff Summary

- Harris Road (One Segment): IDOT Jurisdiction Transfer from Village of Grayslake.
- Harris Road was added to the County Highway System at the July 12, 1994 meeting and is currently under the jurisdiction of three entities; Fremont Township Road District, the Village of Libertyville and the Village of Grayslake.
- This transfers the jurisdiction Village of Grayslake portion (*1 Segment*) of Harris Road to Lake County.

Body

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a segment of Harris Road is still under the jurisdiction of the Village of Grayslake; and

WHEREAS, this County Board of Lake County, Illinois, by prior resolution at its meeting of July 12, 1994 added a portion of Harris Road south of IL Route 137 to IL Route 137 as a designated highway to the county highway system; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Grayslake and Lake County are desirous of entering into an agreement for the jurisdictional transfer to Lake County of the one remaining segment of Harris Road from IL Route 137 to Peterson Road from the Village of Grayslake to Lake County to become part of the Midlothian Road Extension in its entirety as generally depicted in the map attached as Addendum I to said agreement; and

WHEREAS, a draft copy of said agreement between the Village of Grayslake and the County is attached hereto entitled as Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by this County Board of Lake County that the County Engineer of Lake County is authorized and is hereby directed to negotiate and prepare the final Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer from the Village of Grayslake to Lake County for the one remaining segment of Harris Road from IL Route 137 to Peterson Road to become part of the Midlothian Road Extension.

BE IT RESOLVED that the County Clerk and the Chair of the Lake County Board be authorized and they are hereby directed to execute the final Local Agency agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer. The County Engineer shall transmit in writing the final Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer to be executed by the Chair of the Lake County Board and the County Clerk.

BE IT RESOLVED that a copy of this Local Agency Agreement for Jurisdictional Transfer, when executed in its final form, be submitted to Illinois Department of Transportation for their approval and final processing.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS AGREED that the County Board of said County will pass a resolution providing for the transfer of the above location and shall attach hereto and make a part thereof a copy of the resolution, and

Include for Township/Road Districts Only

WHEREAS, the authority to make changes to the Township Road District System is granted to the Highway Commissioner under Section 6-201.3 of the Illinois Highway Code.

The Conveyor Agrees to prepare a map of the above location and attach a copy of such location map hereto.
