Project Description: The intent of this project is for the removal and replacement of the Fire alarm panels in Waukegan for Administrative Tower/Courts Complex, the Coroner's office and the Division of Transportation.

A pre-bid conference will be held at Lake County Building, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor Conference Room, 18 N. County St., Waukegan, IL 60085 at 10:00 a.m. on April 17, 2013. Pre-bid attendance is not mandatory, but recommended.

A 10% security deposit must accompany the bid. The successful bidder must furnish a satisfactory performance bond and a payment bond each in the full amount of the bid.

All work performed under this contract shall be in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, including but not limited to the Illinois Employee Classification Act, the Wage Determination of the Secretary of Labor, provisions of the Illinois Prevailing Wage Act 820 ILCS 130 et seq., and the Illinois Workers on Public Works Act, 30 ILCS 570/ et seq, including Public Act 096-0929 signed into law June 16, 2010. With respect to the Illinois Workers on Public Works Act, the level of unemployment in the State of Illinois has exceeded 5% for two (2) consecutive calendar months.

Lake County, in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively insure that the contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement will be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder without discrimination on grounds of race, color, or national origin.
